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HORIZONTAL FEATURES

➔ Printing empty certificates models with or without CN Codes

Printing empty certificates models without the CN code is now possible for all certificates models, e.g. EU Import.

When selecting the printing options for languages, a new tick-box allows to avoid the CN code mention in the empty certificate model:





The system will now prevent the submission of CHED-D/Ps in which all three 2011/884 accompanying documents are uploaded. Users must provide **either** the Analytical Report 2011/884 & Health Certificate 2011/884 **or** the Statement 2011/884. Only one of these two document combinations is permitted for a valid submission.



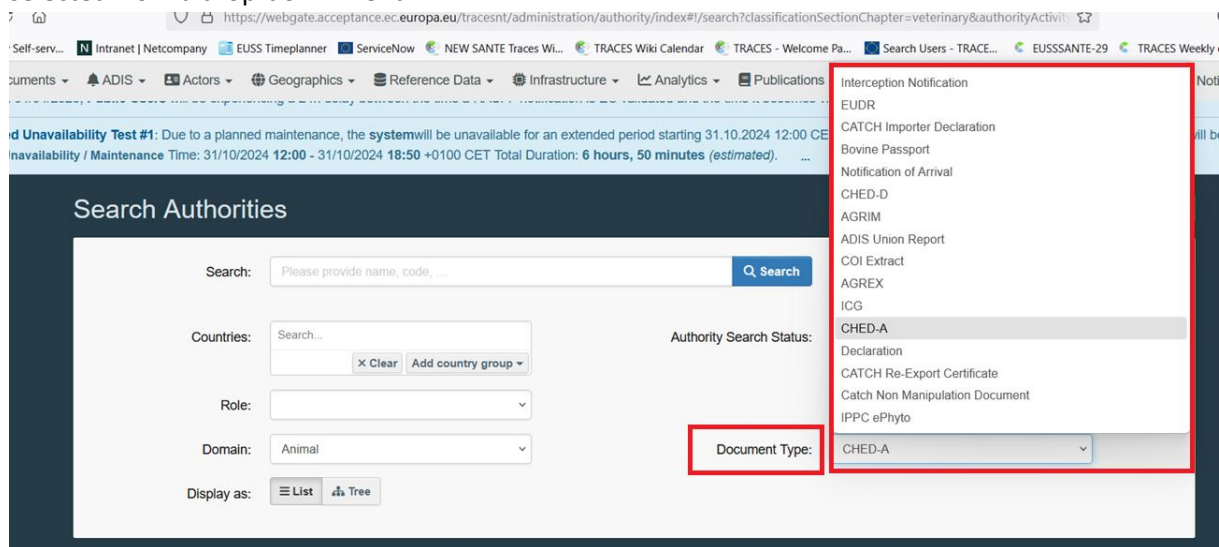

New advanced search option for the Authority search screen

A new advanced search option has been introduced on the authority search screen allowing users to search authorities by the type of document these authorities can access. The document type can be selected from a drop-down menu:



Virtual BCPs now clearly marked

It is now possible to distinguish between real and virtual BCP. The “virtual BCPs” are not real BCPs facilities but were created in TRACES to allow MS to select a controlling authority when performing controls on certain wood packaging material in areas other than BCPs.

Inside the BCP activity detail the option “Authority activity: Virtual” can be set to “Yes”. The green V is automatically displayed next to the BCP’s code inside the authority’s details:

Operator detail validation when an operator group is deleted

To delete an operator group, open any operator that is part of the group and click onto the “Actions” button inside the operator group and select the delete option. Don’t forget to click the save button on top of the operator page.

NOTE: When deleting an operator group the group that is linking the operators together is deleted, not the actual operators:



When requesting the deletion of the operator group TRACES automatically checks the uniqueness of the operator data and an error message appears, when for example two operators who were formerly part of the group share an EORI number. In this case an error message appears warning the user that the uniqueness of the data is not respected. The user needs to open all operators to check, which operators share the same references and make sure that these references are deleted in all but one entry.

Confirming the deletion is only possible when all data that can only be shared, if the operators are part of the same group of operators are unique.


➔ Improvements

Change of display “Last modified by” in Operator’s details.

For confidentiality reasons, the username of the related TRACES account will be displayed to indicate the last person who modified the operator.

The TRACES account information will be accessible via a link, allowing authorized individuals to view the identity of the last user who modified the operator.

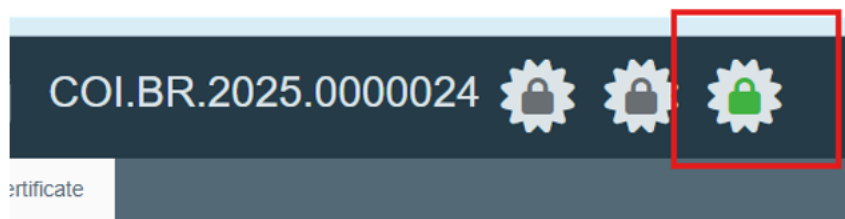
