

# TRACES Release Note - V.8.2.0

*May 2026*

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## HORIZONTAL-FEATURES

### ➔ Enable bookmarked URL from a previous search

The system now preserves and fully applies search parameters when accessing TRACES search pages saved as bookmarked URLs.

When opening a saved or bookmarked search URL, the system now automatically:


- Restores both basic and advanced search criteria
- Displays the corresponding results without requiring manual interaction (e.g. reopening the advanced panel or clicking “Search”)

This improves usability for recurring searches, such as annual verification of certificate or operator data.

### ➔ Improved certificate/ document specimen generation options

It is now possible to download new Empty certificates / documents without selecting CN codes using the additional option “Do not include CN codes”.

In addition, a new ‘compact’ option allows generating simplified version of the certificate specimen, with or without CN codes



### ➔ Add country code of establishment when using CSV/Excel import tool for description of commodity

In case the description of commodities includes the mention of an establishment, ie Establishment of Origin, Cutting Plant, Manufacturing Plant, etc, the CSV/Excel import template now includes a column [Country] to allow users to specify the country code of the establishment. This aims to prevent TRACES failing to retrieve the correct establishment in case of an existing duplicate combination of activity identifier and activity type, which is prevented inside a given country but not globally across different countries.



## ➔ The name of the Means of Transport in the search filter for documents and certificates

The Advanced Search menu for documents and certificates now includes the name of the Means of Transport as a filtering criterion for better convenience. Here it is illustrated for CHED:



## AUTHORITY MANAGEMENT

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

NCPs/ LCPs must be allowed to manage contact details of own authorities

NCP and LCP authorities can now manage the contact details (including opening hours, phone number) of all authorities within their scope, based on authority domains and geographical criteria.



## USER MANAGEMENT

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

#### Search for only suspended users

A search option was introduced in the user search screen that enables authorities and admin users for all organizations to search for users that were suspended on the level of their user account, for example when they updated the second factor authentication for their EU Login account:



## Notification of pending User Request count on Welcome page of Authority/Organic Control Body/Other Body users


A new notification reminder has been introduced for users with an authority role, an organic control body or a role defined as “other body” (i.e. a Country Admin). This reminder displays the number of users currently waiting for validation and it is displayed at the same level as the dashboard of pending certificates on the welcome page:

## CHED / NOA

### ➔ **BUG FIXES (CHED-PP)**

#### HTTP 500 Error When Filling Box I.7 in CHED-PP with a CP from Another Country

A minor bug affecting Box I.7 has been fixed.

When selecting a control point from a country different from the authority issuing the CHED-PP, saving the document in progress, and then changing to another BCP, a system error would occur. This issue has now been resolved.

### ➔ **IMPROVEMENTS (CHEDs)**

#### The "%" character present in the uploaded Accompanying Documents breaks the download link

The “%” character, if present in the filename of the Accompanying Document that is uploaded to TRACES, no longer breaks the link generated to download the document.

#### Improvement for FoCs statistics in case of multiple hazards / tests for the same commodity

Border Control Posts inspectors can now select which applicable Frequencies of Checks (FoCs) associated with the physical checks performed during official controls on CHEDs. A confirmation pop-up will appear upon CHED validation or rejection to support more accurate statistics. The confirmation pop-up will be activated only when the physical checks box is activated.



## Addition of a free-text Box when "Other" is selected as Reason of refusal for CHED / INTRA / NOA

A free-text comment field is now available when "Other" is selected as the reason for refusal in CHEDs, Intras, and NoAs.

When selecting "Other" as the reason of refusal, you can now add an optional comment to better explain the decision. This improves traceability and the quality of refusal data:

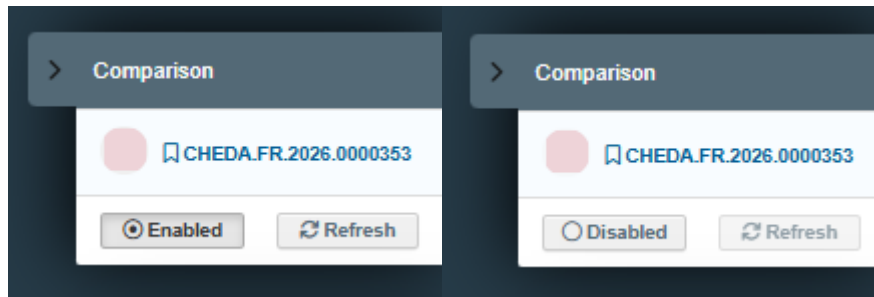


## Improved comparison view for "Replaced" CHED documents and NoA

When using the "copy as replacement" feature in the CHED and NoA, a comparison feature is now available. It highlights the Boxes / fields that have been modified in both the original document and the replaced version.

A new "Comparison" menu has also been added above the existing **Shortcuts** menu. You can hide and display at will by clicking the 'Enabled' or 'Disabled' buttons:

## Improvement to Box II.18 in the “Authorised for Transfer” workflow

Box II.18 is now automatically populated with the control point details entered in Box I.20 during the “Authorised for transfer” workflow.


Previously, Box II.18 was only displayed when rejecting a consignment.

In addition, Box II.18 is now visible and mandatory when “Acceptable for transfer” (Box II.9) is selected and Pre-filled, while remaining editable by inspectors if adjustments are required



## ➔ IMPROVEMENTS (NOA)

Activation of the “Details of non-compliance” tab in NoA for specific commodities

The “Details of non-compliance” tab is now available in the rejection workflow for goods listed in PART B of annex XI of Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2072 (article 73 of **Regulation (EU) 2016/2031**).


## ➔ IMPROVEMENTS (CHED-P)

Rejection of a CHED-P in case of an establishment of origin not registered on the list of EU Approved establishments

### Instructions for the Responsible for the Load agent

When a consignment is presented under a CN code *excluding* composite products, e.g. 0302 31, if the establishment of origin, EoO, is not available in the list of EU Approved establishments, it is possible to select or create a generic establishment, under section FOOD-OTHER, in status “New” or “valid”. The system displays a warning message but allows to submit the part I of the CHED-P:

“Non-approved establishment(s) of origin indicated - the consignment is likely to be refused entry into the Union *Test Establishment, - FOOD-OTH (Other establishments)*”

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS




#### Management of duplicates Means of Transport and search results display


When creating a Means of Transport (MoT) through the Box I.15 Means of Transport of the certificate, e.g. EU INTRA, the system now checks for existing records with the same country and licence plate, helping you avoid duplicates.

## MANAGEMENT OF CONTROLLED LOCATION

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

#### Allow LCP/ NCP users to manage controlled locations

Management of controlled locations (Control Points) has been clarified and aligned with authority roles.

Only authorised competent authorities (LCP, NCP, and other relevant authority roles) can manage controlled locations, in line with their geographical scope and authority domains.

The “Create” and “Manage” options are no longer allowed to Border Control Posts Officers, to avoid confusion.

For the authorities allowed to manage these Controlled locations, the management of contact details (e.g. opening hours) has been extended aligning with existing rules for managing Border Control Posts contacts details.

## EU INTRA

### ➔ BUG FIXES

A 2nd "Sign Planning" action on AJL no longer removes the link to/from the associated EU Intra

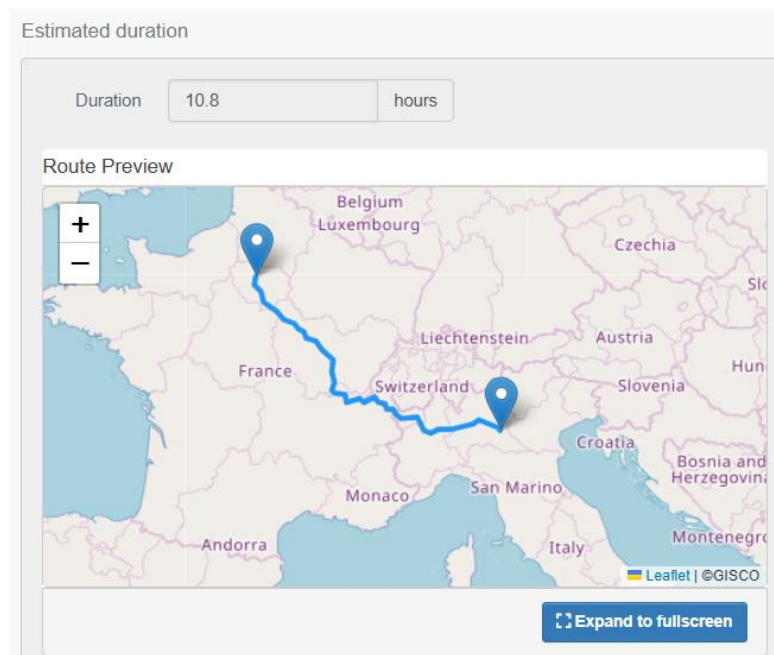
The association between the EU Intra and the linked Journey Log, AJL, is now maintained after re-signing the AJL planning, ensuring continuity of the link in the certificate.

If the EU Intra is still in **New** status, the AJL can still be searched and re-added if needed. If the EU Intra is already **Validated**, re-linking remains not possible.

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

Route Plan – Integrated map preview in certificates (INTRA / EXPORT)

You can now view a Route Plan map preview directly within TRACES from the estimated duration field when a single route plan is available, with the option to open it in full screen for improved readability.



## Reduce target recipients of EU Intra notification

EU Intra notifications are now more precisely targeted, reducing redundant messages and ensuring that only relevant stakeholders receive updates. Each actor receives a notification only once, even if they appear in multiple roles (e.g. Consignee and Place of Destination).

## Passport number field creation

Users creating CANIS-FELIS-FERRETS-INTRA certificates must now provide a valid passport number in the required format, the number must start with an EU/EFTA country two letters ISO code followed by numbers and/or letters. The information will be visible both in the electronic certificate and in the printed PDF.


## DOCOM

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

#### Reduce targets of DOCOM notifications

DOCOM notifications are now more specifically targeted, ensuring that only relevant authorities are informed and that duplicate or unnecessary notifications are avoided.

## ANIMAL JOURNEY LOG (AJL)

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

#### Data Protection regarding Section IV.5

Section IV.5 is now treated as **confidential information**. Depending on the user role, access to the driver's personal information may be restricted.

For users without the required authority rights, the content of Section IV.5 is now masked and displayed as "\*\*\*\*\*".

This confidentiality treatment may also apply to Box I.1.2 where applicable, to protect personal data entered in relation to the driver.

In PDF outputs, these fields will also be masked to ensure consistent data protection across formats.

## ESTABLISHMENT AMENDMENT LISTS

### ➔ BUG FIXES

#### Special characters in establishment name not displaying correctly in PDF List

Some approved establishment names containing **special characters (e.g. circled numbers such as ①, ②)** did not display correctly in the **PDF version** of the approved establishments list. In such cases, these characters appeared as empty Boxes or incorrect symbols in the PDF, while they displayed correctly in the online view and Excel export.


## ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

### Permanent display of comment section in LMS module for the listing procedure of Approved establishments

In the past months, a few miscommunications between non-EU authorities and European Commission officials in charge of approving the listings of Approved establishments in TRACES has been signalled to the helpdesk.

As an attempt to improve this communication scheme, the comment section will be made permanently visible in the interface. Instead of being hidden or only accessible via interaction, the comment fields will be displayed permanently and will be presented in a larger format to improve readability.

This ensures that comments are always visible to users, making key information easier to notice and reducing the risk of overlooking important notes during processing.

#### Transporter operator access to EU Export certificates (Transporter role visibility)

Users linked to transporters mentioned in EU Export certificates can now access and retrieve these certificates, ensuring consistent access rights across certificate types.

### ➔ IMPROVEMENTS

#### Configurable signatory titles in certificates (Part II)

The signatory label in Part II of certificates is now configurable via the certificate model, replacing the previously fixed text (e.g. “Official veterinarian / official inspector”).

Where relevant, depending on the certificate model, a new mandatory attribute **“Signatory titles”** has been introduced in the certificate model, allowing one or more predefined titles to be selected.




#### PHYTO - new descriptor column for “state of processing”

A new optional field “State of processing” has been added in the “Description of the commodity” section (Box I.8). The available values are based on the IPPC standard (Table 3 – Description of condition or state of processing, version 1.1) [IPPC Specific Condition.pdf](#).

You can now therefore specify the state of processing of the commodity when completing PHYTO certificates, in line with IPPC requirements.



## Make the "non-business entity" as on CHED available on PHYTO

It is now possible to use a non-business entity in Boxes I.1 "Exporter" and I.3 "Consignee", similar to the functionality already available in CHED-PP. It will be possible to fill these fields without the need of creating an operator in TRACES (i.e. in case of a natural person).

*"Using a non-business entity is not recommended because they are not controlled by any authority and you cannot re-use them."*



## Alignment of product types with ePhyto guidelines

The product type values in TRACES are now fully aligned with the ePhyto Hub standard. As a result, the selected values will be transmitted consistently.




## Suggested option for PHYTO certificate - treatment of a whole consignment

You can now apply or remove a treatment for the entire consignment more quickly, without having to select each line individually:




## Copying part II when duplicating or replacing Phyto

The information contained in Part II of the phytosanitary certificate is now duplicated when using the “Copy as New” function, as well as in replacement, carried out by an authority.

This includes data such as Box II.10, Additional Declarations, Special Requirements, and inspection fees.



#### Update of exporting countries list in line with current legislation

Norway and Iceland have been removed from the list of exporting countries to align the system with the current legislation.

Operators from these countries can no longer be selected in **Box 5 – Exporter** and **Box 13 – Producer**

They can no longer initiate **COIs as exporters**.

#### Mandatory EORI validation introduced for Importer and RFL

The EORI identifier is now a mandatory field and is included in the COI model for Importers (Box 12):


## Notify Importer when COI is Issued.

## COI - Advanced search: add filter by BCP
