	I, the undersigned state/official veterinarian certify that:		
	II.1. The animals, being exported into the Russian Federation, are clinically healthy, born and reared in the EU, are vaccinated not earlier than 6 months and not later than 2 weeks before shipment against:		
	· Foxes, Arctic foxes - canine distemper;		
	· Ferrets (also Polecat, Polecat-Furo, Thorzofretka, Honorick) - canine distemper;		
	· Raccoons - canine distemper;		
	· Minks - canine distemper, parvoviral enteritis;		
	II.2. The animals, being exported into the Russian Federation, originate from premises that are officially free during the last 12 months from the following contagious diseases:		
	· All species - spongiform encephalopathies, viral encephalomeilitis of any type, rabies;		
	· Foxes, Arctic foxes - Aujeszky's disease, tuberculosis, dermatophytosis (Microsporum or Trichophyton spp);		
· Ferrets (also Polecat, Polecat-Furo, Thorzofretka, Honorick), Minks – tuberculosis;			
· Raccoons, Squirrel, Ermine (stoat), Siberian weasel (kolinsky), Marten, Sable – dermatophytosis;			
· Minks - tuberculosis, Aleutian disease;			
II.3. The exported animals have been in the place of origin since birth or more than 3 months and were kept for 21 days in quarantine under the supervision of the Official State Veterinarian of the exporting country. The animals were healthy during this period and had no contacts with other animals. The minks were tested in an official laboratory using the OIE recommended methods for Aleutian disease with negative results (indicate the method, name of the laboratory, date of testing).			
II.4. The means of transport are treated and prepared in accordance with the requirements approved in the EU.			
II.5. The route plan is attached.
