II. Health information			
<b>Part II: Certification</b>	I, the undersigned State/official veterinarian certify that:		
	1.	Feed and feed additives of animal origin, exported to the Republic of Moldova destined for animal feed were manufactured by establishments, approved/registered by the Competent Authority in the EU and are under control of this authority.	
	2.	Feed and feed additives originates from processing establishments which have not been placed under animal health restrictions.	
	3.	Raw materials of animal origin are derived from healthy animals which were slaughtered for human consumption and subjected to ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection (when necessary). Raw materials of animal origin such as honey, milk etc. comply with the relevant legislation of the EU.	
	4.	Meat and offal of bovines, sheep and goats from which feed and feed additives of animal origin is manufactured are derived from animals that originate from a country or zone with a negligible or controlled BSE risk in accordance with Regulation (EC)No 999/2001. Specified risk materials (SRM) were removed according to Regulation (EC) No 999/2001.	
	5.	Processed animal protein derived from ruminants and products containing such protein were not used to produce feed and feed additives excluding milk proteins, except those feed and feed additives are intended to feed fur or pet animals.	
	6.	Raw materials are derived from animals that were not subjected to the exposure of natural or synthetical estrogenic, hormonal substances, thyreostatics, antibiotics, other drugs and pesticides, used prior to slaughter no later than authorised by instructions on how to use them.	
	7.	Feed or feed additives were obtained from raw materials of animal origin treated not lower than 133 °C for the duration of not less than 20 min with the pressure of 3 Bars or the authorised alternative treatments applied under the supervision of a competent service of the EU Member State and gives the relevant warranty in relation to the established microbiological standard.	
	8.	Feed and feed additives of animal origin were produced according to Regulation (EC) No 183/2005 laying down requirements for feed hygiene.	
	9.	Single-use containers and packaging material are intact and correspond to hygienic requirements of the EU.	
10.	The means of transport comply with the requirements of the EU.
