|  | II.1.   | Non-canned/dry pet food of animal origin, exported into the Customs Union was manufactured by establishments, approved or registered by the Competent authority in the EU Member State on delivery of goods for export and are under regular control from this Authority.  |  |
|  | II.2.   | Non-canned/dry pet food of animal origin originates from processing establishments which have not been placed under animal health restrictions and from raw materials derived from animals whose carcasses and internal organs are fit for human consumption according to veterinary sanitary expertise.   |  |
|  | II.3.   | Meat and offal of bovines from which non-canned/dry pet food is manufactured are derived from healthy animals that originate from herds where there is no case of Bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) and do not belong to birth cohorts of BSE positive animals. Meat and offal of sheep and goats for production of non-canned/dry pet food of animal origin are derived from healthy animals according to the OIE Animal Health Terrestrial Code recommendations for scrapie. Specified risk materials (SRM) were removed according to the OIE Code recommendations. |  |
|  | II.4.   | Non-canned/dry pet food was obtained from raw materials of animal origin treated not lower than 133°C for the duration of not less than 20 minutes with the pressure of 3 Bars or the authorised alternative treatments applied under the supervision of a competent service of the EU Member State and gives the relevant warranty in relation to the established microbiological Standard.   |  |
