Dry or semi-humid feeds or supplements (extruded or pelletised), containing ingredients of animal origin, meet the following requirements:</p> <p>(1)either ○ [II.1.1. they contain meat-and-bone meal of ruminant origin that originates in a country which is recognised by the OIE as of negligible risk for BSE and in an establishment qualified by the SAG to export to Chile(2)]</p> <p>(1)or ○ [II.1.1. they contain meat-and-bone meal of ruminant origin, and they have been reduced to a maximum size of 50 mm, and then subjected to heat treatment in an atmosphere of saturated steam, having a temperature of at least 133°C for at least 20 minutes, with an absolute pressure of 3 bars and they have been produced in an establishment qualified by the SAG to export to Chile(2)]</p> <p>(1)or ○ [II.1.1. they do not contain meat-and-bone meal of ruminant origin, and they have been produced in an establishment qualified by the SAG to export to Chile(2)].</p> <p>II.1.2. each batch has been subjected to a microbiological analysis and complies with the following standards(3)(4):</p> <p>Salmonell absence in 25 gr. n=5, c=0, m=0, M=0. a:</p> <p>Enterobac n=5, c=2, m=10, M=300. teriaceae:</p> <p>II.1.3. in case they contain ingredients of plant origin, they do not exceed the maximum levels of mycotoxins for this type of product, according to the EU legislation.</p> <p>II.2.
