	II.1. The bumble bees or their colonies (<i>Bombus</i> spp.) come from:		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · EU country where small hive beetle (<i>Aethina tumida</i>) and the <i>Tropilaelaps</i> mite (<i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp.) are officially notifiable diseases and originate from a controlled environment (isolated structure, laboratories etc.,) free from these diseases and located in an administrative territorie(s) not under restrictions from these diseases; · a controlled environment (isolated structure, laboratories etc.,) which is under supervision of the Competent Veterinary Service in the EU; · the establishment referred to in box I.11 was inspected immediately prior to dispatch and all bumble bees and breeding stock show no clinical signs or suspicion of the following diseases: <i>Locustacarus</i>, <i>Crithidia</i>, <i>Aspergillus</i>, <i>Sphaerularia</i>, acute apium paralysis, Kashmir virus, entopox virus also in the absence of mites growing in pollen, in places of cultivation, <i>Melittobia</i>, <i>Braconid</i>, <i>Vitula edmandsii</i>. 		
	II.2. The bumble bees as well as their packaging have undergone a visual examination to detect the occurrence of the small hive beetle (<i>Aethina tumida</i>) or their eggs and larvae or other infestations, in particular <i>Tropilaelaps</i> mite (<i>Tropilaelaps</i> spp.), affecting bumble bees.		
	II.3. Selection of the bumble bees or their colonies was done at least 30 days and/or queen bumble bees 1-3 days before export.		
	II.4. Feed used during transportation originates from the administrative territorie(s) not affected by notifiable contagious bumble bee diseases and had no contact with not healthy bumble bees;		
	II.5. Containers and packaging materials are used only once and comply with requirements of the Customs Union.		
	II.6. The means of transport was treated and prepared in accordance with the requirements of the exporting country.
