	<p>II.2 The salamanders have been examined and do not show clinical signs of infection with the fungus <i>Batrachochytrium salamandrivorans</i> (Bsal), and in particular skin lesions and ulcers, at the time of the examination which took place within a period of 24 hours prior to the planned time of dispatch of the consignment to Great Britain.</p>								
	<p>II.3 The consignment of salamanders has been isolated from other salamanders at the latest at the time of the examination referred to in point II.2 and the consignment has not been in contact with other salamanders since that time.</p>
