Breeding and fattening pigs exported into Georgia are clinically healthy and originate from:</p> <p>2.1. territories of the EU Member State or administrative territories according to EU regionalisation that are free from the following contagious diseases, according to official findings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - African swine fever; - Foot and mouth disease and Classical swine fever; <p>2.2. premise(s) where in the recent period before dispatch of the pigs no cases of the following contagious diseases were registered:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Aujeszky's disease – during the last 12 months; - Anthrax - during the last 20 days; <p><input type="checkbox"/> whereas the breeding pigs have been vaccinated against swine erysipelas not later than 14 days before dispatch</p> <p>3. The animals have not received:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - any stilbene or thyrostatic substances; - oestrogenic, androgenic, gestagenic or b-agonist substances for purposes other than therapeutic or zootechnic treatment (as defined in Council Directive 96/22/EC). <p>4. The exported animals were kept for not less than 21 days in quarantine under the supervision of the State/official veterinarian of the exporting country and had no contacts with other animals. Animals were clinically healthy during this quarantine period and have been tested with negative results, as appropriate, in an accredited laboratory using the methods approved in the EU or recommended by the WOAHA Manual of Diagnostic Tests and Vaccines for Terrestrial Animals (indicate the name of the laboratory, date and method of testing) for Brucella suis(1).</p> <p>5.
