	a)	Newcastle disease as regulated by Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687;	
	b)	highly pathogenic avian influenza as regulated by Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687.	
	3.	The hatching eggs come from a flock, which has been kept in an establishment in which no confirmed case of infection with low pathogenic avian influenza viruses has been reported for at least 21 days prior to the date of collection of the hatching eggs, as similarly foreseen by the provisions laid down in Article 106 of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/692.

10. The containers and vehicles, in which the boxes mentioned above have been transported, have been cleansed and disinfected before loading in accordance with the instructions of the competent authority.
